SATELLITE EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT

Solaris has committed to provide a Satellite Emergency Department on the Muhlenberg campus that will provide basic emergency care to the community 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The board-certified physicians and emergency nurses will treat conditions such as asthma, burns, broken bones, and fevers.


IMAGING & LABORATORY SERVICES

In addition to emergency services, Solaris will also offer local residents the opportunity to continue to use the Muhlenberg campus for a host of routine outpatient procedures such as blood work, x-rays, CAT scans, PET-CT, ultra-sound, MRI and mammography.



HOME HEALTH CARE

The Muhlenberg Homecare Program will continue to deliver exceptional service to the community. The program provides skilled nursing, physical, occupational and speech therapists, certified home health aides, clinical dietician and social work. Telehealth Monitoring is also available.



MOBILE INTENSIVE CARE UNIT (MICU)

For more advanced emergency medical needs (those requiring advanced life support), Solaris will continue to provide Mobile Intensive Care Units (MICU) from its Muhlenberg campus.

DIALYSIS TREATMENT

Together with Davita Healthcare, the Dialysis Center on the Muhlenberg Campus provides weekly care to more than 100 patients who require this critical service.

REHABILITATION SERVICES


From in-hospital to outpatient rehabilitative care, the JFK Johnson Rehabilitation Institute (JRI) offers a number of locations for its nationally renowned comprehensive rehabilitative services for both pediatric and adult patient populations. JRI is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) for its Comprehensive Inpatient Rehabilitation, Brain Injury, and Comprehensive Vocational Evaluation programs. It is also accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations.

PEDIATRIC REHABILITATION SERVICES

The Pediatric Rehabilitation Department of the JFK Johnson Rehabilitation Institute is dedicated to improving the well-being of children and their families. The goal is to facilitate a child's skills in all developmental areas including movement, cognition, communication, social-emotional health, psychosocial health, and adaptive behavior. Programs are also geared to help family members adjust to the impact of living with a handicapped child and to develop nurturing and caregiving skills. The pediatric rehabilitation programs bring together resources, specialists and technology to help each child lead a healthy, fulfilling life.



JFK MEDICAL CENTER MAP & DIRECTIONS



PARKWAY — NORTH OR SOUTH

If you are traveling either North or South on the Garden State Parkway take Exit 131. At the top of the ramp, bear right onto Route 27 South. Proceed approximately 1-1/2 miles on Route 27. Make a right at Dunkin' Donuts onto James Street. JFK Medical Center is on the left.

TURNPIKE — NORTH OR SOUTH

If you are traveling either North or South on the New Jersey Turnpike take exit 11. Bear right after passing through the toll plaza and enter onto the Garden State Parkway North. Take the parkway to exit 131. At the top of the ramp bear right onto Route 27 South. Proceed approximately 1-1/2 miles on Route 27. Make a right at Dunkin' Donuts onto James Street. JFK Medical Center is on the left.

ROUTE 1 — NORTH OR SOUTH

Traveling North or South on Route 1, take the Menlo Park Mall/Parsonage Road Exit. Follow Parsonage Road for one mile to the traffic light at Route 27. Continue straight (Dunkin' Donuts will be on right, Rite Aid on left), and cross

Route 27, where Parsonage Road becomes James Street. JFK Medical Center is a short distance on the left. Trucks and buses should be aware of the low clearance on Parsonage Road.

ROUTE 287 — SOUTH

Traveling South on Route 287, take Exit 3 for Metuchen/New Durham. Turn left at the traffic light. Continue through TWO traffic lights then follow road as it bends to the left and becomes Route 27 North. Go to the 5th traffic light and turn left at Rite Aid onto James Street. JFK Medical Center is a short distance on the left.

ROUTE 287 — NORTH

Traveling North on Route 287, take exit 1A for Route 1 North. Take the Menlo Park Mall/Parsonage Road exit. Follow Parsonage Road for one mile to the traffic light at Route 27. Continue straight (Dunkin' Donuts will be on right, Rite Aid on left), and cross Route 27, where Parsonage Road becomes James Street. JFK Medical Center is a short distance on the left. Trucks and buses should be aware of the low clearance on Parsonage Road.

NORTH ROUTE 27

Proceed North on Route 27 through Edison and Metuchen and back into Edison. At Rite Aid, turn left onto James Street. JFK Medical Center is a short distance on the left.

OUTERBRIDGE CROSSING

Follow Route 440, which becomes Route 287 north at Edison. Traveling North on Route 287, take exit 1A for Route 1 North. Take the Menlo Park Mall/Parsonage Road exit. Follow Parsonage Road for one mile to the traffic light at Route 27. Continue straight (Dunkin' Donuts will be on right, Rite Aid on left), and cross Route 27 where Parsonage Road becomes James Street. JFK Medical Center is a short distance on the left. Trucks and buses should be aware of the low clearance on Parsonage Road.

THE SATELLITE EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT AT THE MUHLENBERG CAMPUS — *What You Need To Know*

The Satellite Emergency Department on the Muhlenberg Campus Provides Community Access to Basic Emergency Care

The Muhlenberg Campus is committed to serving the needs of the community, providing area residents with access to round-the-clock care. As such, JFK Medical Center, an affiliate of Solaris Health System, will maintain a Satellite Emergency Department at the current site of the Muhlenberg Emergency Department. The Satellite Emergency Department (SED) will continue to provide urgent care with the same trusted, experienced and board-certified physicians, specialty trained nurses and other healthcare professionals you have worked closely with over the years.

WHAT ARE THE CAPABILITIES OF THE SATELLITE EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT?

Serving the community 24 hours per day, seven days per week, the Satellite Emergency Department at the Muhlenberg Campus is staffed with a team of board-certified emergency physicians and nurses, offering the same capabilities as a conventional Emergency Department. It is able to evaluate and initiate stabilizing treatment for the same wide-range of conditions typically cared for in a traditional emergency room setting.

WHAT SERVICES WILL BE PROVIDED AT THE SATELLITE EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT?

As with a conventional hospital emergency room, the SED will treat patients with health problems that require immediate, specialized attention. Specifically, it will offer care for adult and pediatric patients with minor injuries and illnesses such as:

- general medical conditions: colds, flu, sore throats, ear aches, sinus infections
- mild asthma exacerbations
- minor burns
- sprains/broken bones
- fevers/rashes
- lacerations/stitches
- upper respiratory conditions
- urinary tract infection
- mild allergic reactions
- minor musculoskeletal and head injuries
- wound care
- minor motor vehicle/work injuries

Additionally, free transportation for patients and families is available to all who require transfer to an acute care setting.

The SED will provide:

- Diagnostic Imaging/Radiology services: X-ray, ultrasound, CT-scan
- On-site laboratory testing
- Waiting areas for families during the care, treatment and/or observation of patient.

WHAT HAPPENS IF THE SED DETERMINES THAT HOSPITALIZATION IS REQUIRED?

The staff at the SED will stabilize those patients who require transfer to an acute care hospital; and a specialty care transport vehicle will be available to transfer patients to JFK Medical Center or other hospitals as appropriate.

WHEN IS IT APPROPRIATE FOR EMTs TO TRANSPORT PATIENTS DIRECTLY TO A FULL-SERVICE ACUTE CARE HOSPITAL?

Patients who require advanced life support, critical care, surgery, advanced radiological and laboratory testing, are in labor, or suffer from medically complex conditions should be brought to and cared for at the closest acute care hospitals. Such types of patients are:

- Individuals treated by advanced life support personnel or mobile intensive care units and require advanced life support care
- Individuals with psychiatric emergencies, under the influence of alcohol or other substances, or demonstrating altered mental status
- Young children with high fever or "ill-appearing" children
- Women more than 20 weeks pregnant with conditions relating to pregnancy
- Individuals likely to require advanced testing, treatment or in-hospital admission for such conditions as chest pain, respiratory distress, syncope, stroke, surgical emergencies, major trauma, intentional overdose and severe infections.

JFK Medical Center has increased its acute care capacity to accommodate such patients.

WHERE IS THE SATELLITE EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT LOCATED AND WHAT ARE THE HOURS OF OPERATION?



FREE Hospital Transportation Services For Plainfield Area Residents



The Muhlenberg Campus is pleased to bring to the Plainfield area community Free transportation to residents who do not have an alternative means of transport. These services are available to patients who need access to hospital based services at JFK Medical Center and Trinitas Hospital.



Three levels of Ambulatory transportation are available to meet the need of Area residents:

FREE SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE

A Free Shuttle Bus is offered to and from JFK Medical Center for patients and visitors who require non-emergency medical services

- Runs continuously during designated hours between the Muhlenberg Campus main entrance JFK Medical Center. No appointment is necessary.
- Hours of Operation: 12:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m., 7 days a week.

FREE MEDICAL TAXI SERVICE

The Medical Taxi assists with transportation needs for non-emergency services at JFK Medical Center, providing door-to-door, round-trip transportation services.


- Available to area residents upon request. Please request this service when calling JFK Medical Center for an appointment.

FREE TAXI VOUCHER SERVICE
