## Plainfield Mayor Adrian O. Mapp partners with USPS on Job Fair

**Plainfield, NJ** — As part of a joint community outreach, Plainfield Mayor Adrian O. Mapp is partnering with USPS Northern New Jersey District officials to host a special postal job fair on Thursday, Aug. 21 from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m., at City Hall, 515 Watchung Avenue. The mayor and postal officials will open the event at 4 p.m. with welcoming remarks on the steps of City Hall. The general public is invited.

Job fair attendees will be able to apply and learn about the various job openings at New Jersey postal facilities. The current postal job openings include: clerks, carriers, temporary holiday employees, motor vehicle operators / truck drivers, and auto mechanics. Attendees are encouraged to bring their resumes.

“Building partnerships with stakeholders like the USPS is important to Plainfield’s future; this upcoming job fair is a blessing that will open doors to more job opportunities for our residents.” says Plainfield Mayor Adrian O. Mapp.

The U.S. Postal Service is one of the nation’s largest employers with a nationwide career workforce of 500,000 employees, including more than 21,000 in New Jersey. The majority of the Postal Service’s entry-level workers are hired through a competitive process, which begins when a job application is submitted. USPS human resources professional will be on hand at the Aug. 21 job fair to answer questions and assist attendees with their applications.
