ATTENTION RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF PLAINFIELD COMPREHENSIVE HOUSING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (CHAP)

Financial assistance is available for the rehabilitation of owner-occupied one, two and three family homes to assist residents in the removal of unsafe conditions in their dwellings, such as plumbing, heating/energy, electrical, lead-base paint, roofing, structural, siding and wall masonry, exterior painting, interior improvements and premise repairs. Funding is provided under the local Rehabilitation Program. To be eligible for assistance, applicants must meet federally recognized income guidelines:
